Welcome to level one. Thankfully this transition has not needed a great deal of planning and preparation. A lot of what we were doing has been maintained as we have found it very settling for both students and teachers.

We do ask that you stay outside the gates until 8.30a.m if you are accompanying your children to school. This time is very valuable for the teachers as they prepare resources etc for the learning day. I have noticed that the school grounds are still clearing very quickly after school, which means our road petrol monitors can get back inside before the high school students start arriving at the crossing.

The two half hour breaks are still proving to be popular for a significant range of reasons. Both the students I have asked and the majority of teachers are enjoying the new timetable. Further consultation will take place next week to ensure everyone on site has input into the long term decision relating to break times.

We look forward to enrichment recommencing again next term, and the return to full school assemblies from week 2 if the community transition of covid remains at zero.

The migration from the Linc-Ed to Hero student management system is completed. We are trialling the interactivity of this new platform in a range of tasks at the moment. We aim to open the platform to parents later today. Full instructions about how to manage this transition in the home setting will be shared with everyone once we are sure the platform is fully operational.

Thank you for sending children along with jackets, hats, gloves etc, to allow them outside during the cold but sunny weather. They certainly are enjoying the outdoors, especially since there is so much space for them to engage in whatever outdoor activities they choose.

There is another Mana Ake Zoom drop in session planned for any families who would like to have a discussion about any concerns they have relating to your family. Next week a booking calendar will be shared with all families to enable you to book a time that suits you.
