Assembly will be held on even weeks in the school hall starting at 9:15am. Parents are welcome to attend.

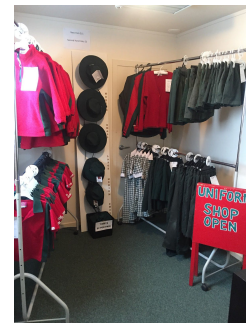

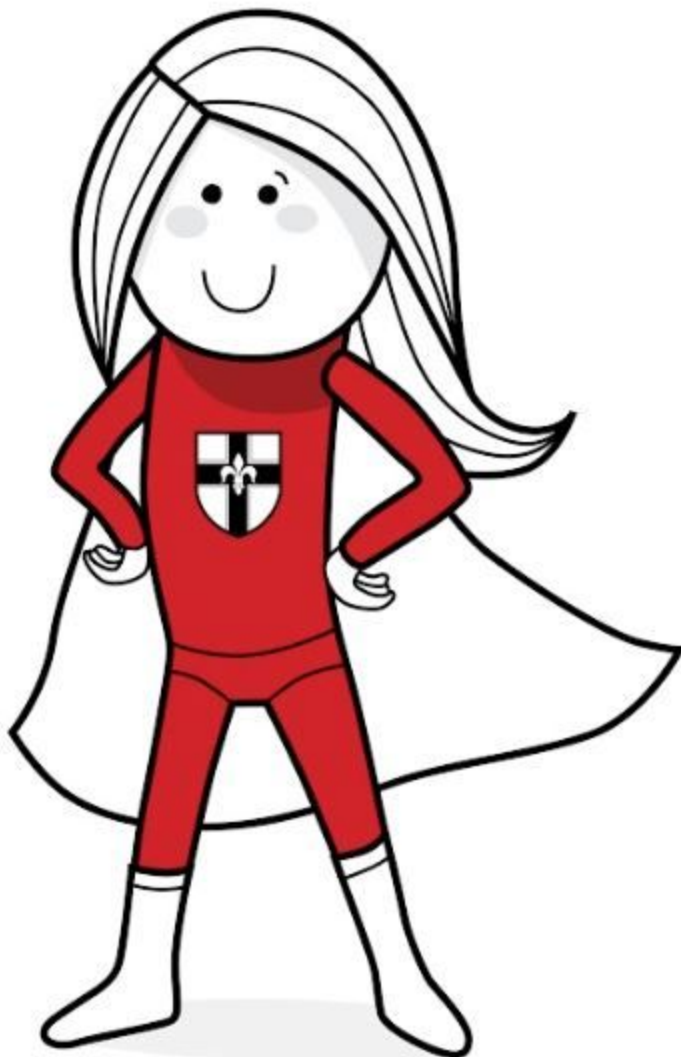
